Group Responsibilities and Expectations

The staff of PMBC desires to give you the best retreat experience we can offer. In order to get the fullness of that experience we ask your group to honor the following behavioral responsibilities and expectations.

- 1. We strive to keep the lounges in the dining hall a clean and comfortable place for you to relax and fellowship between your group's activities. Please help us keep these areas tidy by returning dishware to the dish area and disposing of trash in the wastebaskets.
- 2. PMBC is a safe and enjoyable place for many children. To keep PMBC safe please provide reasonable supervision of children during all activities and usage of PMBC equipment.
- 3. Our indoor activity options are fun, but when you're done, please prepare it for others to enjoy. Return equipment to its proper place and in orderly condition (i.e. air hockey table turned off, no paddles out of place, basketballs returned to the ball rack, board games neatly packed in their box). Sometimes our equipment or games break, let us know so we can repair it for you.
- 4. We desire to provide enjoyable outdoor activities. Please return items for those games where they belong. Equipment get damaged or lost when they're left outside, we really appreciate you helping us by putting things back.
- 5. We seek to provide you with well kept facilities and equipment. We appreciate your help by letting us know if any equipment or facilities are damaged [even if you did it :-)] to prevent anything worse from happening.
- 6. We want you to have the utmost comfort and rest during your stay. Sleeping directly on the mattresses or mattress covers without utilizing sheets or a sleeping bag will ruin the mattresses. If someone forgets linens, please let us know so that we can accommodate your need.
- 7. We seek to provide you functional and practical Wi-Fi service. Unfortunately, our infrastructure can't sustain dozens of devices pulling on the system. We ask group leaders to be discerning as to who they allow access to the network.
- 8. We seek to provide comfortable conditions. Please be reasonable with the heat and air-conditioning. Make sure to close doors when you leave a room. We would also appreciate you adjusting the temperature to a lower setting when you check-out.
- 9. Thank you for being mindful of the words you use, what you watch or listen to. There are children around camp, please don't expose them to coarse language or inappropriate images.
- 10. Please dress modestly. No revealing clothing or extremely tight clothes. No midriff showing. As far as the pool is concerned, please, no two-piece bathing suits for girls over the age of 7 and men should refrain from wearing speedos.
